

Flemming Konradsen – Bio

Flemming Konradsen is professor at the University of Copenhagen and Senior Vice President of the Social & Humanitarian programme area and part of the management team at the Novo Nordisk Foundation. Prof. Konradsen is also Chair of the Grundfos Foundation.

Konradsen has 30 years of research, programming and teaching experience in the fields of environmental and global health. He was the Director of the School of Global Health at the University of Copenhagen from 2007-2022, has since 2007 been a Visiting Professor at Emory University, Atlanta, US and affiliated with various universities in the Nordic region. During the period 2011 to 2021, Konradsen was a member and, from 2014, Chair of the Research Committee for Development under the Danish Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Flemming Konradsen has been a member of numerous review panels and advisory committees under various national research councils. Konradsen has lived and worked mainly in South Asia and East Africa and has worked for international research organizations, UN organizations, development NGOs and national health authorities and research institutions. Research methods include epidemiology, ecological field surveys, qualitative studies, costing studies, health promotion and health system analysis.
